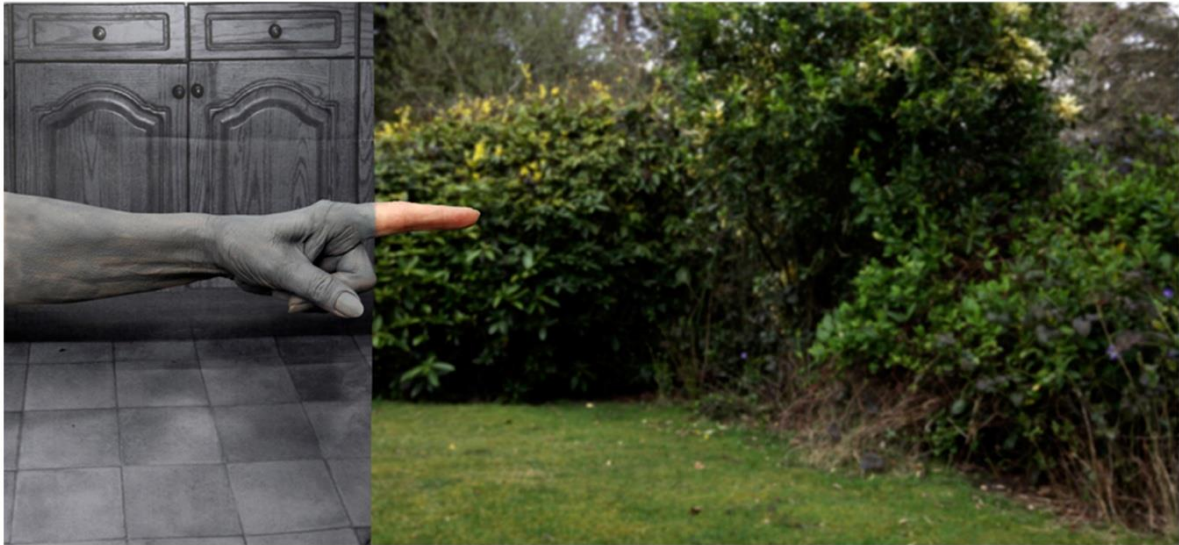

What is Photo Academy?

Photo Academy is a unique five day course running in the Summer Half Term Holidays from **29th May – 2nd June 2017** with **Jonny Briggs** *Archisle Jersey International Photographer in Residence 2017*.

Can something good come from breaking the rules?

Can mistakes help you in the creative process?

Can something good come from confusion?

This course will explore the role of photography in generating questions and discussions. We will attempt to photograph blind, challenge ourselves to photograph the most boring thing we can find, attempt to take what we think is a bad photograph, resulting in a group discussion about the 'blind' 'boring' and 'bad' works. We will make rules for photographing, that others have to follow. We will then break those rules. We will take photographs of fragments of ourselves, that when placed back together like a puzzle, form distorted portraits. We will make photomontages that merge bodies with landscapes, and will embark on photo walks to take some of the projects. Humour is welcomed.

Artist Statement:

In search of lost parts of my childhood I try to think outside the reality I was socialised into and create new ones with my parents and self. Through these I use photography to explore my relationship with deception, the constructed reality of the family, and question the boundaries between my parents and I, between child/adult, self/other, nature/culture, real/fake in attempt to revive my unconditioned self, beyond the family bubble. Although easily assumed to be photoshopped or faked, upon closer inspection the images are often realised to be more real than first expected. Involving staged installations, the cartoonesque and the performative, I look back to my younger self and attempt to re-capture childhood nature through my assuming adult eyes.

Jonny's new commissioned project is currently on show at the **Saatchi Gallery**, London in the exhibition ***From Selfie to Self-Expression*** the world's first exhibition about selfie culture throughout history.

Jonny studied at Chelsea College of Art and the Royal College of Art, London. Awards include Saatchi Gallery UK/raine Finalist, a 2014 Paul Huf nomination (Brett Rogers), Foam Talent 2014, the 2011 Conran Award for Fine Art, a Lumi Honorary Art Award (2011), Saatchi New Sensations 2011 Winner, The Catlin Prize finalist 2012, and a NESTA Creative Sparks Award.

Solo exhibitions include Photoforum Pasquart Photography Museum in Switzerland 2017; N Contemporary at MC2 Gallery, Milan 2015; Marie-Laure Fleisch, Rome 2015; Julie Meneret, New York City 2014, Simon Oldfield Gallery, London 2013; FaMa Gallery, Verona 2012; and White Project, Paris 2012.

Jonny's work has been published in the British Journal of Photography, The Guardian, The Times, The Independent, Arte, Aesthetica Magazine, Elephant Magazine, La Stampa and national newspapers of France, South Korea and The Netherlands, and documentaries of the work have been shown on Channel 4, Sky TV and French and German cable TV. Jonny continues to live and work in London.

An **exhibition of photographs** taken by the group will take place on Friday evening 2nd June and Saturday 3rd June at St James Centre. This will be a great opportunity for family, friends and the public to view emerging local talent. Participants will get to keep the images they make on the course!

Course times are **10am - 4pm** with mid-morning, lunch and mid-afternoon breaks. Drinks and snacks are available and participants can bring a packed lunch. Participants must be between **school/college year 9 to year 13** (inclusive), preferably be able to bring their own camera, laptop and most importantly have a keen desire to learn and do photography! Working groups will be organized to be age appropriate.

Whatever you want from photography: a hobby, a course at school or college or even your chosen career, don't miss this chance to work with professionals and have fun doing it!
