What is Photo Academy?

Photo Academy is a unique five day course running in the Easter Holidays from 10th - 14th April 2017 with Tanja Deman Jersey International Photographer in Residence 2017.

Tanja Deman is an internationally successful artist working in the medium of photography, collage, video and public art. Her work is inspired by human interactions with the natural world. Tanja creates large scale photo montages, giant public art installations and underwater photographs that talk about environmental issues in new and exciting ways.

Tanja obtained her Master of Fine Arts at the academy of Fine Arts in Zagreb. Her work has been exhibited in numerous international exhibitions including: Museum of Contemporary Art, Zagreb; 15th Venice Biennial of Architecture; Kunstmuseum Bonn; Museum of African Design, Johannesburg; TENT, Rotterdam: Unseen Amsterdam; International Film Festival Rotterdam; Moscow (CHA); Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art, Rijeka; MUNTREF Centro de Arte Contemporaneo, Buenos Aires.

The course is designed to be fun, friendly and cater for a wide range of abilities, all within the fantastic facilities at **St James Centre**.

Tanja will share her knowledge and experience about photography and photo collage with participants and teach them how to make landscape photography or how to construct imaginary landscapes with photo materials, in order to tell a story, express an idea or convey a feeling. She will show examples of her own work by other exciting artists, photographers, film makers, architects and explain how they are done. Participants will then have the chance to try out their own ideas and styles and working as individuals or in small groups under Tanja's supervision and support. Karen Biddlecombe, Archisle Communications Assistant, will also be on hand to offer guidance, feedback and encouragement.

An **exhibition of photographs** by the group will take place on Saturday 15th April: at St James Centre. This will be a great opportunity for family, friends and the public to view emerging local talent. Participants will get to keep the images they make on the course!

Course times are **10am - 4pm** with mid-morning, lunch and mid-afternoon breaks. Drinks and snacks are available and participants can bring a packed lunch. Participants must be between **school/college year 9 to year 13** (inclusive), preferably be able to bring their own camera, laptop and most importantly have a keen desire to learn and do photography! Working groups will be organized to be age appropriate.


