A Photography Workshop with Tanja Deman - Archis/e Photographer in Residence 2017

Saturday 19th & 26th August at the Societe Jersiaise - 9.30am - 2.30pm

Tanja Deman is an internationally successful artist working in the medium of photography, collage, video and public art. Her work is inspired by human interactions with the natural world. Tanja creates large scale photo montages, giant public art installations and underwater photographs that talk about environmental issues in new and exciting ways.

Tanja obtained her Master of Fine Arts at the academy of Fine Arts in Zagreb. Her work has been exhibited in numerous international exhibitions including: Museum of Contemporary Art, Zagreb; 15th Venice Biennial of Architecture; Kunstmuseum Bonn; Museum of African Design, Johannesburg; TENT, Rotterdam: Unseen Amsterdam; International Film Festival Rotterdam; Moscow (CHA); Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art, Rijeka; MUNTREF Centro de Arte Contemporaneo, Buenos Aires.

In the workshop participants will be assisted in the process of photographic image making on locations, photo-editing and will be given one to one tutorials on technical and conceptual aspects of developing their own body of work.

Workshop will include:

- Intro lecture, Q&A and instruction
- Photographing on location
- Photo editing & tutorials
- Presentations and feedback
